NATIONAL CONCERTS REGISTRATION AGREEMENT

This Registration Agreement (the "Agreement"), effective as of Sep 8, 2023, is made between Browning High School with an address of 105 US-89; Browning, MT 59417 ("GROUP") whose representative's signature appears below, and National Concerts, LLC with an address of 380 Mountain Road, Suite 1808; Union City, New Jersey 07087 ("NC") whose representative's signature appears below. GROUP and NC agree to the following:

WHEREAS, NC facilitates the collaboration of qualified performance ensembles for rehearsals, performances and artistic programs in Stern Auditorium at Carnegie Hall in New York City (the "Artistic Program"); and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the Artistic Program, NC also provides other optional services such as transportation to New York City, accommodations in New York City, meals and entertainment (collectively, the "Additional Services"), all of which are described in more detail in the NC Brochure, attached to this Agreement as Exhibit A (the "Brochure").

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree as follows:

I. PERFORMANCE

A. Services to be Provided.

- Artistic Program. NC shall provide to GROUP, at the price set forth in the NC Brochure, the Performer and Non-Performer Inclusions for the program as set forth in the Brochure in New York City spanning March 10-13, 2024 with a final concert at Carnegie Hall scheduled for March 12, 2024.
- Additional Services. NC shall provide those Additional Services selected by GROUP in the Ensemble Registration Form, a copy of which is attached to this Agreement as Exhibit B (the "Registration Form") at the prices set forth in the Brochure. Selection(s) of Package Options on the Ensemble Registration Form shall be binding on GROUP.
- 3. <u>Repertoire Selection</u>. The repertoire to be performed shall be communicated to GROUP no later than six (6) months prior to the final concert date.

B. GROUP Preparation.

- GROUP agrees to arrive in New York City with music thoroughly prepared for performance. If not musically prepared, NC reserves the right to exclude GROUP from rehearsals and/or performance without refund.
- 2. Guest conductors are permitted to request spot checks from singers or quartets from participating ensembles during rehearsals.
- 3. To ensure full contribution to the musical success of the performance, GROUP agrees to submit a recording of their ensemble performing the work(s) to be rehearsed and performed in New York City no later than thirty (30) days prior to their arrival. To submit such recording GROUP may send digital mp3 audio file(s) to NC by following the directions on our file transfer site: http://bit.ly/nationalconcerts
- 4. Every performer in the GROUP shall be required to attend the mandatory rehearsals. (Attendance by non-performers is optional.) Failure of any performer to attend mandatory rehearsals may subject such performer to exclusion from the performance.



II. PAYMENTS AND DELIVERABLES

A. GROUP and NC agree to the following schedule:

October 1, 2023	\$200/person non-refundable payment due ("Payment #1") in addition to completed and signed Registration Agreement and Ensemble Registration Form. REQUIRED TO SECURE PARTICIPATION. Selection(s) of Package Options on the Ensemble Registration Form shall be binding on GROUP.
December 1, 2023	 Additional \$300/person non-refundable payment due ("Payment #2") Denial or Acceptance of Full Refund Assurance Plan form (attached to this Agreement as Exhibit C), due. Completion of Personnel & Rooming List (web-based). If the Personnel & Rooming List is not timely completed, a late fee of \$50 shall be charged.
February 1, 2024	 Payment of the lesser of (i) \$300/person or (ii) the remaining balance due under this Agreement is due ("Payment #3"). If Hotel package option elected, any changes to the Personnel & Rooming List after this date shall incur a change fee equal to \$50 per change.
March 1, 2024	Any remaining balance is due. ("Payment #4").

B. Payments from GROUP in the form of a check or money order should be made payable to:

- C. Billing Statements based upon GROUP's number of participants (performers and non-performers) ("Participants") will be sent promptly following receipt of each payment received. This statement will indicate payment due dates and will include a payment summary.
- D. When any payment is late, and no prior arrangements have been made and consented to in writing by NC, a late fee totaling 5% per month of the amount due will be assessed and added to the final balance. If a late payment is anticipated and unavoidable, NC must receive a due date extension request in writing at least five days prior to the due date, and such request shall be considered in NC's sole discretion.
- E. Participants with outstanding balances as of the arrival date of GROUP in New York City will not be allowed to participate.

III. REFUND POLICY

- A. Payment #1 is non-refundable. If an individual Participant cancels before Payment 2 is due, the funds attributable to such Participant from Payment 1 may be transferred to the outstanding balance for GROUP for up to a maximum of 10 Participants.
- B. If an individual Participant or the GROUP cancels after the Payment 2 due date, the first \$400 per person of fees shall be non-refundable.
- C. No monies are refundable or transferable for Participants who cancel within 30 days before arrival to New York City.



- D. Notwithstanding Section A-C above, full refunds are available for individuals or the entire GROUP through the *Full Refund Assurance Plan*, if such plan is purchased by **December 1**, 2023.
- E. In the event the Artistic Program is canceled by National Concerts for a reason other than a Force Majeure Event, all monies will be refunded to GROUP. Notwithstanding that it is a Force Majeure Event, if the Artistic Program is canceled due to shutdowns ordered by governmental authority related to the Covid-19 pandemic, GROUP shall have the option to either (i) roll over the fees paid to NC pursuant to this Agreement to participate in a similar program the following season or (ii) receive a refund of the performer and non-performer fees paid to NC hereunder.
- F. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the provisions of Section IIIA-E do not apply to amounts paid, if any, pursuant to the Airfare Addendum, which shall governed by the terms of such Airfare Addendum.

IV. <u>DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES/LIMITATION OF LIABILITY</u>

All conductors, service providers, hotels, airline carriers, tour guides, etc. providing travel and other services to us, are independent contractors, not our affiliates or agents. We are not liable for the actions, omissions, errors, representations, warranties, negligence, breach of contract, personal injuries, death, property damage, or any other damages or expenses resulting from service providers. We have no liability and will not refund due to an event due to delay, cancellation, overbooking, strike, force majeure, and any other causes that is beyond our direct control. We have no control and are not responsible for any additional expenses, delays, omissions, re-routing, or of acts of interference by the government or legal authorities. Except as expressly stated herein, NC is not making any other warranties, express or implied, including but not limited to any implied warranty of merchantability, habitability, or fitness for a particular purpose. In no event shall NC be liable to group, its participants or any other third party for any indirect, special, or punitive damages regardless of the form of action, whether under contract, tort, strict liability, negligence or any other legal or equitable theory with respect to this agreement service (except to the extent otherwise required by applicable law) for any lost profits, or special, direct or indirect, incidental, punitive, or consequential damages of any kind whatsoever. NC's aggregate liability with respect to this agreement shall not exceed \$500.00.

V. ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- A. <u>Professional Conduct</u>. GROUP agrees to conduct itself professionally during rehearsals, in the hotel, restaurants, concert hall, rehearsal facilities, reception, and while transporting to, from and while in New York City. Contrary behavior may result inexclusion from rehearsals and/or performance as well as the above-mentioned venues without refund. GROUP understands it is fully responsible for the behavior of its Participants and will be responsible for any costs associated with any actions of its Participants.
- B. <u>Confidential Information</u>. GROUP agrees to preserve as confidential all information related to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, including any attachments and exhibits.
- C. <u>Stolen Items/Damage</u>. GROUP is responsible for any damages to and/or items stolen from hotel rooms, rehearsal facilities, and/or concert halls.
- D. <u>Change of Venue</u>. If the arranged venue becomes unavailable due to a Force Majeure Event, as described in this Agreement, NC reserves the right to move the Artistic Program to another venue and such change of venue shall not be considered a breach of this Agreement by NC.
- E. GROUP will indemnify, defend and hold harmless NC, including its members, directors, officers, employees or agents, from any claims or liability arising out of relating to this



Agreement unless caused by NC's gross negligence or intentional misconduct. GROUP releasesNC from any damage to, destruction of, or total or partial loss, via theft, misplacement or otherwise, of GROUP's personal items during the performance residency in New York City unless caused by NC's gross negligence or intentional misconduct.

F. Amendment. This Agreement may be amended by mutual consent and signature of both

G. Entire Agreement. This Agreement, including any exhibits hereto, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to its subject matter and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings between the parties, written or oral, with respect to the same. In case any provision in this Agreementis held invalid, illegal or unenforceable that finding shall not affect the other provisions of this Agreement.

H. Force Majeure. In no event shall NC be liable to GROUP for any delay, cancellation or failure in the performance of its obligations hereunder arising out of or caused by circumstances outside NC's reasonable control, including but not limited to strikes, labor disputes, accidents, government requisitions, acts of God, pandemics, epidemics, or

government restrictions (a "Force Majeure Event").

I. Choice of Law, Arbitration. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of New York without regard to the conflict of law provisions thereof. The parties hereby agree to submit any dispute arising under or in any way related to this Agreement solely and exclusively to binding arbitration to be submitted to and conducted by the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") in accordance with the rules of the AAA in force at the time of the arbitration. The parties agree that the binding arbitration shall be held at a venue in New York, NY chosen by the AAA, to the exclusion of any other available venue.

VI. COVID-19

While National Concerts and Carnegie Hall are working closely with medical and public health experts—and taking measures to enhance the safety of visitors, artists, and staff—an inherent risk of contracting COVID-19 and other contagious diseases exists in any public space. In order to participate in a National Concerts event and Carnegie Hall performance, GROUP is required to read and accept the following waiver.

By signing this form and registering GROUP, I agree to comply with all health and safety protocols implemented by National Concerts and Carnegie Hall based on applicable federal, state, and local rules and guidelines at the time of the performance, and I agree that:

National Concerts and Carnegie Hall cannot guarantee that I will not be exposed to and contract COVID-19 or other contagious diseases, and all those participating in the National Concerts event do so at their own risk.

I accept the risk of being exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 or other contagious diseases along with all related consequences. I agree that this waiver means I give up my right to bring any claims, including but not limited to claims of negligence.

Admission to Carnegie Hall and any of its events is conditioned on compliance with health and safety protocols. Visitors who do not follow applicable safety protocols may be asked to leave the premises.

National Concerts artists, staff, and visitors have the right to an environment free from abusive, threatening, or inappropriate behavior. National Concerts reserves the right to remove any person acting in an unacceptable or inappropriate manner.



I am delighted to be welcoming you to one of our unique collaborations this season! My staff and I remain committed to you and your musicians' overall experience. And I trust that our obligations to one another are clear.

In the event of unavoidable circumstances, however, I know you will appreciate the comfort of full refund assurance which we offer today. With this letter, we invite your participation in National Concerts' *Full Refund Assurance Plan* ("FRAP"). Participants in this plan shall be eligible to receive a full refund as described below under "Terms". We trust you will enjoy this measure of security.

The *Full Refund Assurance Plan* can be purchased for 1) your entire ensemble participating in a National Concerts performance residency, or, 2) any number of interested individuals from the ensemble. There is a cost reduction if your entire group purchases the plan.

FRAP Group Registration: \$65/person FRAP Individual Registration: \$80/person

Terms

- In order to participate in the FRAP, GROUP or INDIVIDUAL registration must be received no later than GROUP's Payment #2 due date, as stipulated in the Registration Agreement.
- Once participation in the *Full Refund Assurance Plan* has been purchased, plan holders may cancel their participation in the Artistic Program and request a full refund of amounts paid to National Concerts at any time up until 11:59 pm four calendar days prior to such plan holder's departure. (For example, if the departure date is March 24th, notice of cancellation must be received by National Concerts by 11:59 pm on March 20th.)
- Exclusions: Coverage does not include a refund for airfare nor late arrival due to inclement weather or other travel delays.
- Refunds must be requested in writing no later than 11:59 pm four calendar days prior to such plan holder's departure. Refunds requested greater than one month from the departure date will occur within two weeks of request. Refunds requested less than one month from the departure date will occur immediately after the concert date. The refund will be the amount of fees paid to NC (expressly excluding the amount paid for FRAP) on behalf of the plan holder requesting the refund (i.e, if the plan holder requesting a refund is the entire GROUP, the refund will be the amount paid on behalf of the GROUP; if the plan holder requesting a refund is an INDIVIDUAL, the refund will be the amount paid on behalf of such INDIVIDUAL).
