CDA-Resolution Concerning Review of Investment Policy

CDA-Revised Contract of the WRRCSSA between Detroit and Rivercrest

We changed two areas of the contract, Section 5.5 and 5.6 involving if there are only two member schools, as is currently, how the SSA could be dissolved. The other change is 10.1, the last contract stated that each member school will be responsible for transporting its students, Mr. Logan and I agree that this should be a SSA responsibility.

CD-Equity of Student Discipline

We have no major discipline problems, a public school will never have perfect discipline. I have investigated his claims and will present my findings to the board. Mr. Hart claims that several parents, teachers and students report their problems to him because they are fearful of retaliation, from the administration. We have had no parent, student or teacher complaints. All employees of the district know they can trust me with complaints. Retaliation is illegal and something I personally find insulting. I try to conduct our business in a professional manner.
