**TOPIC: Approval of Bid Results for Firewall Replacement – 2013 Bond**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of a new district-wide firewall solution from Sentinel Technologies, Ann Arbor, Michigan for \$137,294.75 plus a contingency of \$13,729.48, for a total cost of \$151,024.23.

**RATIONALE:**

This purchase of district-wide firewall replacement is a planned purchase from the 2013 Bond. It will update and upgrade the District's current firewall, expanding the capacity of the network now, while also allowing for future flexibility and expandability.
