

Lincolnwood Capital Project News Water Transmission Main

This week, the concrete subcontractor poured new curb and pavement patching on Hamlin Avenue from Fargo Avenue to Howard Street. Curb patches were also poured on the east side of Hamlin Avenue from Lunt to Touhy Avenues. The contractor installed the 20-inch transmission main on Hamlin Avenue, from Hull Street to Louise Street. A second crew installed the 20-inch transmission main on Oakton Street from Central Park Avenue to Monticello Avenue. Two additional crews prepared areas for new curb, driveways, and pavement patching, including the pavement patching on Oakton Street. Finally, mechanical work was performed at the valve house for Lincolnwood's reservoir.

Next week, the contractor will continue installing the 20-inch transmission main on Oakton Street west from Monticello Avenue. A second crew will complete the 20-inch transmission main on Hamlin Avenue, from Louise Street to Oakton Street. A third crew will excavate the pavement patch and place aggregate base on Oakton Street, west from McCormick Boulevard. The concrete subcontractor will install new curb and pavement patches on Hamlin Avenue south of Howard Street and on Oakton Street. The mechanical subcontractor will continue installing new equipment at the Village of Lincolnwood valve house.



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
