Attendance Support

Interventions and Support

- Weekly Attendance monitoring
- Individual student & parent meetings
- Connections for support (Counselor, Social Work, referrals to community services)
- <u>U.P.L.I.F.T.</u> (United Partnership for Leadership, Inspiration, Focus, and Transformation)
 - Our goals with this pilot program are to identify and remove barriers, create a support system for youth and their families, and to help our youth be successful in their academic career, leading up to graduation and beyond.

Partnership with Steele County Attorney's Office

- OHS/ALC/OO Friday morning meetings
 - 253 students and families invited to attend
- Attendance Review Board meeting ARB (individual meetings)
 - 40 ARB meetings this school year (OHS since Nov.)
- Truancy Court (started in February)
 - 10 OHS/ALC students referred currently

Impact: 1st Semester

2023-24: 10+ unexcused = 94, 20+ unexcused = 77

2024-25: 10+ unexcused = 66, 20+ unexcused = 41
