**Subject:** Consent Calendar, November Board Meeting. Power Caddy Purchase

Custodial Services is proposing to purchase 53 Clean Core Power Caddy aqueous ozone machines. This machine injects ozone into plain cold tap water, to sanitize restrooms and many other surfaces. The machines can also be used to clean carpet as they produce liquid ozone which is harmless to people but is a powerful cleaning agent. These machines will eliminate the need for many other cleaning agents, making us a greener district while cleaning and sanitizing surfaces. Aqueous ozone has been certified by the EPA as a sanitizer and is Green Seal Certified as safe and effective.

We propose purchasing the machines for each school that does not already have them. One for each single floor elementary, two for each two floor elementary, two for each Jr. High and two or three for each High School. The purchase will be made from Bell Janitorial. This equipment and Bell Janitorial are on the district preferred custodial equipment list and Bell had the lowest bid for the equipment on bid JH21034.

The cost for each machine is \$4,575.00 for a total of \$242,475.00. Funding will come from ESSR III ARP Custodial Account.
