4. Post Secondary Plans & Readiness Rubrics

• One of the strategies we are using to increase graduation rates and prepare all students for college and careers is to create both a post secondary plan and a readiness rubric. The readiness rubric has students self assess their readiness in a number of areas and track their progress. A sample of the 9th grade readiness rubric has been included in this month's report. Research shows that having students set goals and track their own progress creates more buy in and gives students more ownership in their progress. The readiness rubrics are completed during advisory time and are shared with parents at parent conferences.
