Background	Chapter 37 of the Texas Education Code requires that HCJB establish and
	operate a Juvenile Justice Alternative Education Program (JJAEP) for
	youth who are expelled from school for the offenses described in Section
	37.007 (a), (d), and (e) of the Texas Education Code. Chapter 54 of the
	Texas Family Code provides that the juvenile court, at a child's disposition
	hearing, may order the child to attend the JJAEP. School districts may
	contract with HCJB for placement of students in the JJAEP who are
	expelled from school for the offenses described in Section 37.007 (b), (c),
	and (f), Section 37.0081, Section 37.302, or who are ordered to attend
	the JJAEP by a juvenile court, as described in Section 54.04(b) of the
0.00	Texas Family Code.
