This concerns the Knowledge Bowl Competitions sponsored by the Southeast Service Cooperative.

**REQUEST:** Right now, this is one advisory position. I am requesting that it becomes two positions - split into Jr. and Sr. High Knowledge Bowl.

**Jr. High-**Grades 7 – 9

**Teams:** 4 – 5 (6 on a team)

**Number of Students:** 25 – 30 students

**Season:** 3<sup>rd</sup> week of September – 3<sup>rd</sup> Week of January (16 weeks)

**Meets:** 4- one per month – and a 5<sup>th</sup> if they make it to finals (usually the case)

**Time for meets:** 6 hours per meet – including travel and lunch. Last two meets are additional 90 minutes. Coaches are expected to judge, read questions and supervise at the meets.

**Practice:** 30 minutes/week

**Additional:** Coach is responsible for scheduling the events, requesting busses, and other organizational tasks (forms, etc.) Estimate 3 hours for this

**Total Time: 43 hours**

Prac: 8 Hours

Meets: 33 hours

Organizing work: 3 hours

**Sr. High-**Grades 10 - 12

**Teams:** 4 – 5 (5 on a team)

**Number of Students:** 20 – 27 students

**Season:** 2<sup>nd</sup> week of November – 3<sup>rd</sup> Week of March (16 weeks)

**Meets:** 4- one per month – and a 5<sup>th</sup> if they make it to finals (usually the case)

Sr. High can also qualify for a 2 day state meet in Brainard (Has happened twice)

**Time for meets:** 6 hours per meet – including travel and lunch. Last two meets are additional 90 minutes. Coaches are expected to judge, read questions and supervise at the meets.

**Practice:** 30 minutes/week

**Additional:** Coach is responsible for scheduling the events, requesting busses, and other organizational tasks (forms, etc.) Estimate 3 hours for this

**Total Time: 43 hours + 5 for Conference**

Prac: 8 Hours

Meets: 33 hours

Organizing work: 3 hours
