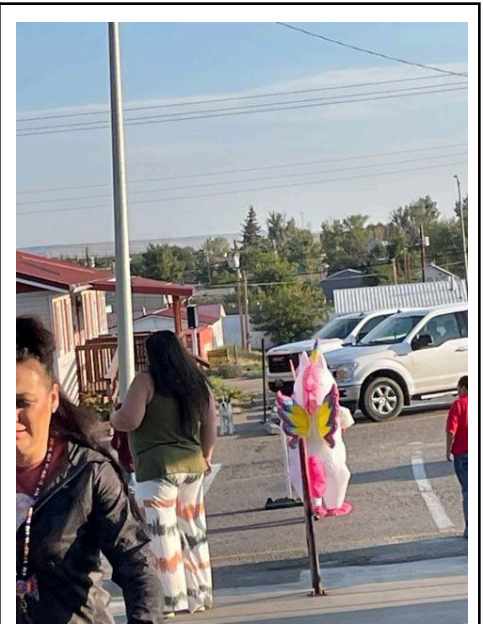
Napi's Vision Statement:

Napi's Mission Statement:

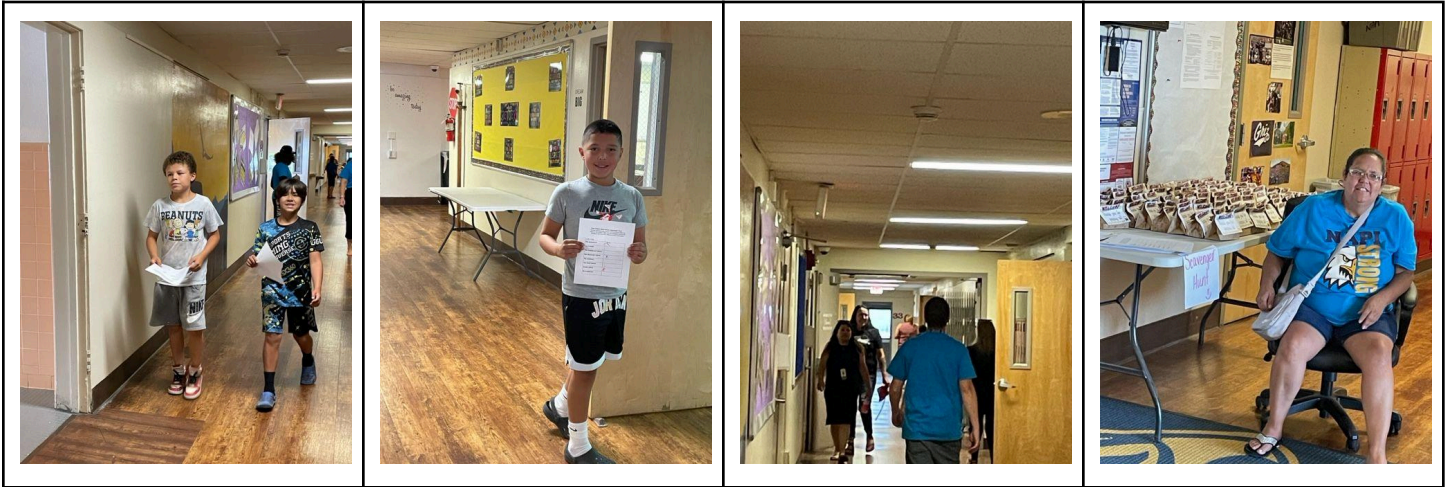
Napi Elementary School is committed to providing high-quality instruction and support to promote the highest achievement of all students, both academically and behaviorally.

Both coaches are so happy to welcome new students, fresh faces, and of course our new staff to Napi Elementary School! The coaches both kicked off the new year by participating in SBE Week at the beginning of August, helping to prepare for the upcoming school year. We aligned the curriculum to both the standards and the new MAST testing, helped gather and distribute instructional materials, and welcomed new staff with a full schedule during New Teacher Orientation. We provided support and assistance with establishing classroom environments and provided overall support to all teachers getting ready to welcome new students. After a long and fulfilling day on August 22, we continued to ensure all materials were available for all students and staff. Both coaches also hit the ground running with the screening of all Tier 2 and Tier 3 students for phonics intervention so that we can begin right off the bat the first week of September. This year, I am the only counselor at Napi Elementary and we have approximately 283 students enrolled in school to date. To provide Tier I counseling services to all students, my plan is to teach 2 specials classes daily (Second Step - Social Emotional Learning Curriculum) and will cover topics such as Empathy, Calming Down, and Problem-Solving strategies throughout the year. Additionally, Tier I services will include both a 4th-grade and 5th-grade daily lunch bunch group for students who are looking for a small alternative environment to have lunch. Tier II services such as Check and Connect, Dessa Small Group, Tamarack Grief Group, and Food/Hygiene will also be provided.
