• January has proven to be an extremely busy and successful month for our Winter Activities. Since the last report we have hosted the Mid-State Dance Championships, Ranger Holiday Classic tournament, twice both Boys & Girls Basketball on the same day, a Wrestling Triangular and numerous Hockey games at the Hallett Arena. Athletics Updates

Dance

 For the 4th year in a row the CIDT won the Mid-State Kick Championship and for the 3rd in a Row were the Overall Conference Champions. It was extra exciting as we were the host site for the Championship and Coach Norwood's team did not disappoint. Four Team members were named Mid-State All-Conference (Hannah Pederson, Raylin Daratis, Brenna Nelson, Londyn Eastwood) and two Honorable Mentions (Cami Armbrust, Isabella Haukous).

Northern Lakes Hockey

• The Boys Northern Lakes Hockey team is 7-6 overall on the season while the Girls are 4-13.

Girls Basketball

• So far on the season the Girls are 10-5 overall, 2-1 in Conference Play and their QRF ranking is #19 in AA. They have had some signature wins over Mountain Iron-Buhl (#1 in A), Holdingford (#17 in AA) and Duluth Marshall (#26 in AA). They will be playing many ranked opponents over the rest of the season including Holy Family Catholic (#16 in AA), Pequot Lakes (#5 in AA), New London-Spicer (#7 in AA) and Minnehaha Academy (#10 in AA). In Pequot Lakes on January 19th Tori Oehrlein broke the All-Time Girls Scoring Record and she will most likely surpass the Crosby-Ironton overall Scoring Record later this year.

Boys Basketball

• The Boys are currently 11-4 overall on the season and 1-1 in conference play. They went 2-1 during the Holiday Tournament including a 3OT win against Fond Du Lac in what Coach Galovich thinks was the first time they went to 3OT since 1987. Conference play is on the Horizon as 4 of the next 5 games are against Conference Opponents.

Wrestling

• After having many events canceled due to weather during December the Wrestlers have finally found their footing on the mat. At the Mid-State Conference Duals last week John Paul Fitzpatrick was named All-Conference and also the MVP for the competition. He has recorded his 100th overall Pin of his career this season and won three individual tournaments. Gabe Ridlon scored his 50th Pin in Grand Rapids last week and won an individual tournament earlier in the season.
