

## 2.2. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

### 2.2.1. Citizen Advisory Committees

Committees appointed by the School Board permit the use of community experts who volunteer their services for the benefit of the School District. Citizen Advisory Committees will be established as needed, recognizing that final action ultimately rests with the School Board.

The membership of continuing citizen advisory committees will be staggered terms of three years. The Board shall promptly designate approximately one-third of the membership of each present committee to one, two, or three year terms, and thereafter, appointments to vacancies will be made annually by the Board at the regular meeting on the fourth Tuesday in August. Chairpersons of all committees will be elected annually by the committee membership at their first school year meeting.
