PROGRAM SALES UPDATE -


We are serving more students! For the month of October we served 2,128 additional lunches over budget. This figure represents 73,545 lunches served in the district. We have experienced an increased in breakfast counts by 1,812 meals over budget for the month of September. This figure represents 39,226 breakfasts served in the district. Promotions such as Breakfast with the Principal have increased interest at several schools. We continue to look for opportunities to serve the district with our scrumptious catering offerings.

As part of the opening Food Service Meeting for all staff, annual food safety and physical safety training included:


This month, as part of the monthly Kitchen Manager Meetings our training agenda is:

As Illinois Valley High School has reached a benchmark of 75.24% of its enrollment qualifying for free or reduced status, we are running a test program of FREE lunch for all students for the month of December.
