



The continuum of services identifies different service delivery models to provide specially designed instruction to a student eligible for special education services.




STUDENTS PLACED IN NON-DISTRICT PROGRAMS

FUTURE PLANNING

- Establish K-2nd and 3rd-5th FAST programs at the elementary level.
- *Add an additional Structured Learning Classroom at the middle school.

Ensure that these programs are staffed appropriately to support the individual communication, social-emotional, academic, and physical needs of students in these programs.

Increase social work and psychologist support for self-contained programs (this support is currently staffed by Mid-Valley for those students in Mid-Valley programs). This may include support of a behavior coach.

WHY?

- Students can be educated in the least restrictive settings within their home school district.
- Students will have additional mainstream opportunities with Geneva peers.
- Students will be provided instruction that is specific to meeting their individual needs by teachers and support staff hired by Geneva School District.
- The District will continue to have a continuum of services that follows a scope and sequence of academic and functional skills.
- *The District continues to identify students who need more intense systems of support.

OFFSETS TO COSTS OF NEW PROGRAMS

- Decrease in Mid-Valley tuition expenses.
- Decrease in Mid-Valley technical support expenses.
- Decrease in transportation costs.


IS GENEVA SEPARATING FROM THE MID-VALLEY COOPERATIVE?


