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**District Goal or Objective Addressed:**

Goal 4: Develop a district-wide culture of value, support, and growth amongst all students and staff.

**Background Information:**

The School Health Advisory Council met over the course of 4 meetings to review, discuss, and develop a recommendation for instructional materials relating to Prevention of Child Abuse, Family Violence, Dating Violence, and Sex Trafficking (Pre-K through Grade 5).

Play It Safe is a widely-used personal safety and child abuse prevention program. It teaches students to:

- Identify safe, unsafe, and confusing touches.
- Understand that their body belongs to them.
- Use the "Say No, Get Away, Tell Someone" safety rule.
- Identify trusted adults they can talk to if they ever feel unsafe or uncomfortable.

The curriculum is presented in a non-threatening, classroom-based format and includes a variety of engaging materials, such as age-appropriate videos and activities. It is tailored for different grade levels, with lessons building upon each other each year.

**Fiscal Implications:**

Approximately \$1,500 annually.
