Purpose- The purpose of this meeting was to approve the quote options that Blooming Valley Services completed for the Reconstruction Bathroom Facility Project that is located behind the Greenbush-Middle River School.

Bathroom Facility

At the previous Meeting on September 20th, Kent Christian was there to ask the city council if they would be willing to donate from the donation fund to help with the Reconstruction Bathroom Project that will be located behind the Greenbush-Middle River School. Kent mentioned how they have two options to choose from. Option one is to demo the old bathroom building and build something new. Costing \$5,000. Option two would be keeping the existing bathroom and building a brand-new bathroom/press box next to field three, costing \$14,200 to install water and sewer services. Council Member Shawn Walsh spoke up mentioning how the city has their own project expenses to cover, that he recommended \$2,000 to donate out of the donation fund as well as having Public Works help get the project started.
