Drug Survey Information

Our students are using drugs and alcohol at or below in the state average.
70 % of our students in grades 6-12 reported that they live in a two parent family.

8 % of our students used tobacco both cigarettes and smokeless tobacco in the past month.

16 % of our students used alcohol in the past month with only 6 % binge drinking (5 or more beers at once).

8 % of our students used marijuana in the past month with <1 % using other drugs in the past month.

11 % of our students used over the counter cough syrup as a drug with only 2 % using other over the counter drugs such as valium, Vicodin, etc.

3 % of our students used inhalants in the past month.
