<u>Student Expressions: Use of School Facilities for Non-school Purposes</u>
(<u>First Reading</u>): Deputy Superintendent Dr. Stephanie Howard presented this item for discussion. This proposed update clarifies language. This policy will be brought back to the board next week for second reading and a vote.

<u>Academic Achievement Class Ranking (First Reading)</u>: Deputy Superintendent Dr. Stephanie Howard presented this item for discussion. The proposed update moves Pre-Advanced Placement courses to a higher grade point average "weight" in order to reward high school students who choose the more challenging, rigorous courses. If approved, this change would go into effect with the incoming 9th graders – the Class of 2024. It would not affect those who have already started high school. This policy will be brought back to the board next week for second reading and a vote.

<u>Presentation of Student Support and Wrap Around Services</u>: ECISD has seven divisions under the heading of Student Support, this presentation focused on two, Teen Parent Related Service and Community Outreach Center. TPRS Coordinator Rose Valderaz and Community Outreach Center Director of School Attendance Scott Randolph each presented on their respective division.

Teen Parent Related Services (TPRS) provides support, in a variety of ways, to keep teen parents in school. Things like providing transportation, child care, an incentive program, and making daily contact are ways the TPRS program reaches teen parents. Last year's graduation rate was 85% for students receiving TPRS support. The department is still working with those who did not graduate.

The Community Outreach Center, located at 301 E. Clements, is where our ECISD social workers keep track of students and families to increase attendance and reduce the dropout rate. This includes monitoring truancy. The department works to connect families with needed community services, and offers a "Parenting Wisely" course to about 250 families each year.
