- 18 students enrolled in course
- Average PSAT score (Spring 2018): 943
- Average SAT score (Spring 2019): 1012
- Average growth of 69 points

Success Story: **Student A** utilized Khan Academy and enrolled in the SAT prep course. **Student A** started with a PSAT score of 670 (Oct. 2017) and ended with an SAT score of 1070 (Dec. 2019)

Next Steps:
