

Our Wise Wolf Ways that we are focusing on this month are paying attention to our "red flag warnings," and getting off our emotional elevator when we are at a lower level. We all have inside red flags that we feel and outside red flags that others can see and hear. When we pay attention to our red flags, we will be able to identify when our energy level is going up and if we are feeling comfortable or uncomfortable. When our energy level is going up, we use wise wolf way #5 and try to exit the emotions elevator at a lower floor, and we do this by using our tools.

The tools we have added to our toolbox this month are the empathy tool and patience. When we use empathy we care about others and we also care about ourselves. Our patience tool helps us to understand that we are strong enough to wait.
