I wanted to take a moment to share a fantastic experience one of our Engineering Design and Development teams had last week. Louie King and Sam Anderson visited ACS Group to gain insight into their project, speak with engineering experts, and tour the facility.

Sam and Louie are working on a solution to reduce 3D printing waste by repurposing the by-product into a useful base material for applications like new filament production and injection molding pellets. ACS, a manufacturer of industrial grinders and granulators for the recycling industry, provided them with invaluable information and even offered to donate some parts to support their project.

Attached is the email to Sam outlining the donated products and their value. Since donations like this are rare, I recall that the school board typically recognizes the donor at a board meeting, and the Central Office handles paperwork to acknowledge the contribution.
