

Report: Field Turf Maintenance, Lion Stadium

The Board has requested information in Report format only related to potential costs for different approaches to rehabilitating the Football Field at Lion Stadium. Coach Brown and Mr, Kain have consulted with several firms and have solicited accurate proposals, good for 180 days, for both natural and artificial replacement for this Field. All proposers / inspectors recognized and advised that the condition of the Field really requires total replacement at this point, natural or artificial. Simpler aeration, top-dressing and fertilization approaches are inadequate to address current conditions.

Several firms declined to offer proposals. This proposal summary includes pricing from firms who have the capacity to handle such a project in high quality, timely fashion. All have strong references and have completed work recently in reasonably close proximity to Ozona. Some we know first-hand.

If the Board reaches a point of serious discussion on this need, we will provide construction detail and arrange presentations and /or site visits if desired. For this report, we simply offer the basic comparison of costs as requested. *These are firm prices, however, not estimates.* If the Board were to determine that resources supported moving on a rehabilitation project before the 2012-2013 school year, any of these firms would need a contract approved no later than February, 2012 to ensure project completion.

In the event that this work was pursued in the near term, all vendors understood that the target for access to demolition would be immediately after Graduation and expectation would be that the field would be fully available for use by first desired scrimmage date in August.
