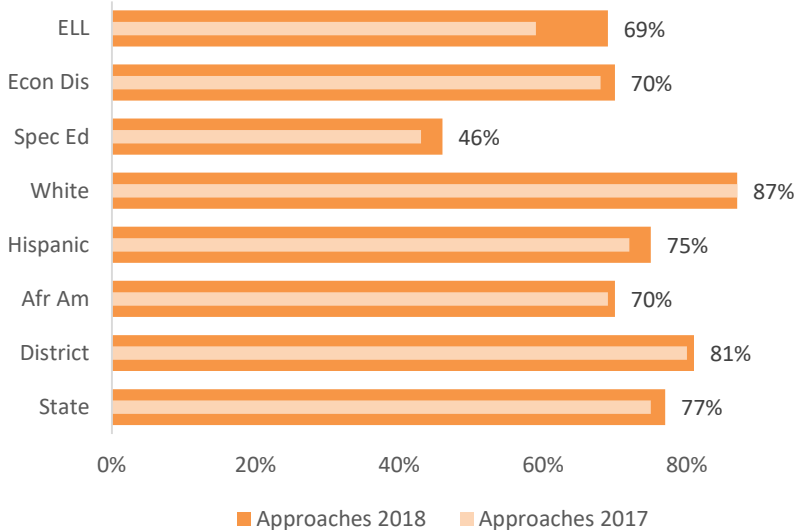

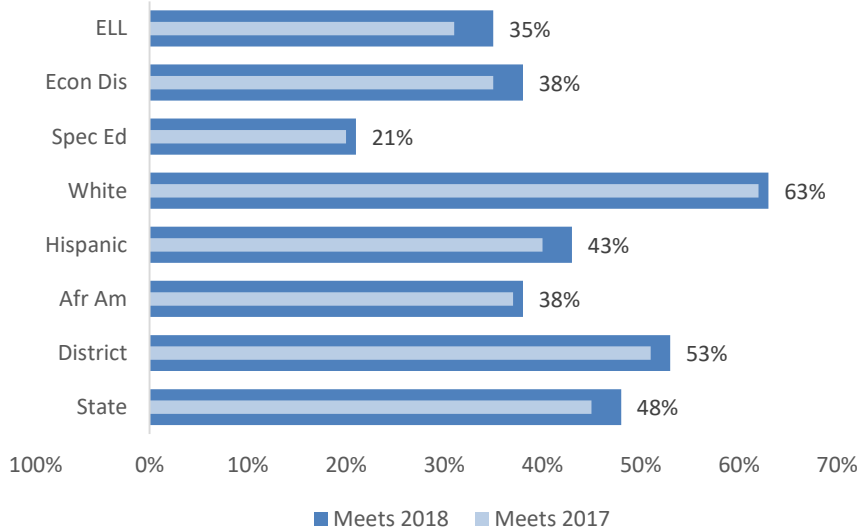

STAAR passing rates in **2018** were very similar to **2017**

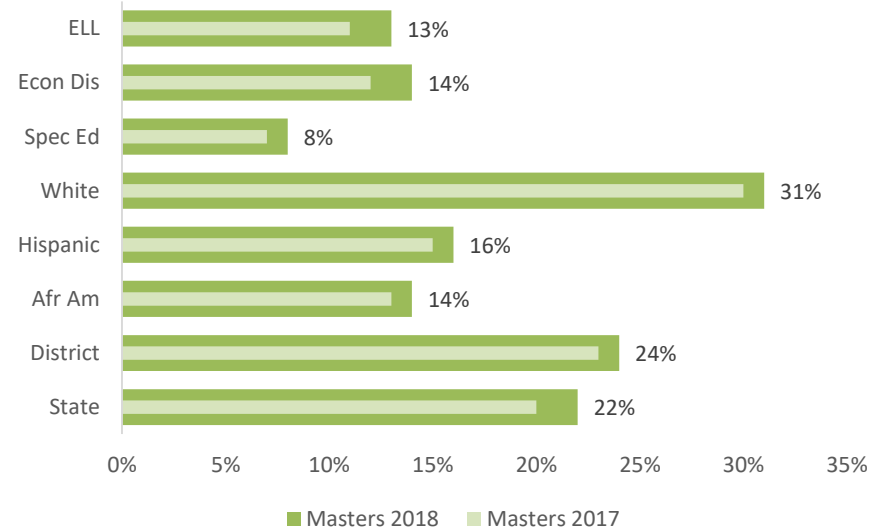
STAAR Percent at **Approaches** Grade Level or Above, All Grades, All Subjects



STAAR Percent at **Meets** Grade Level or Above, All Grades, All Subjects

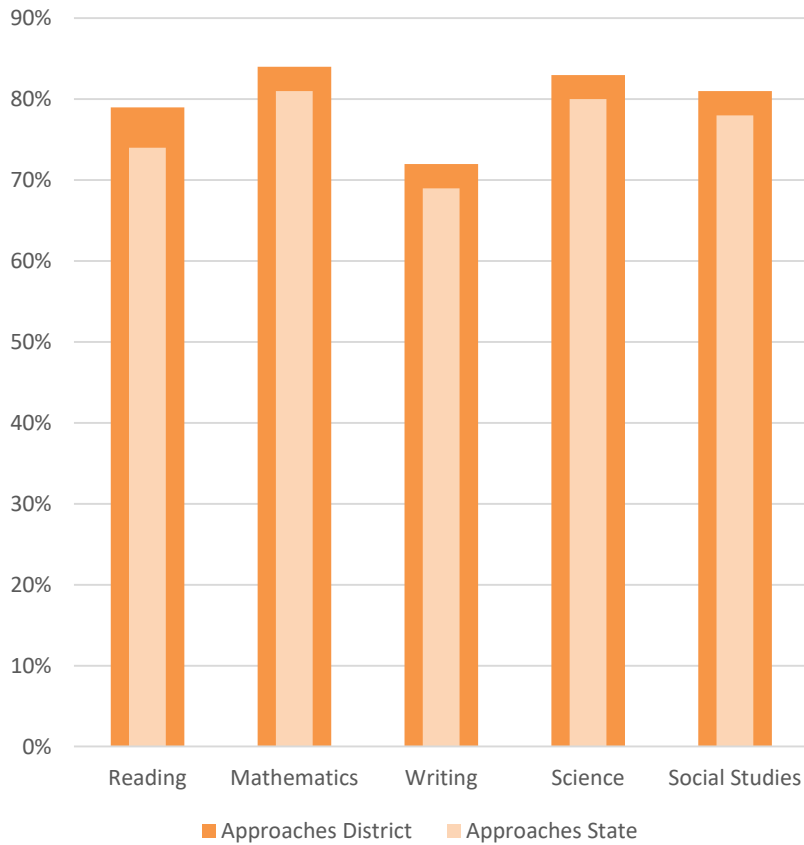


STAAR Percent at **Masters** Grade Level or Above, All Grades, All Subjects

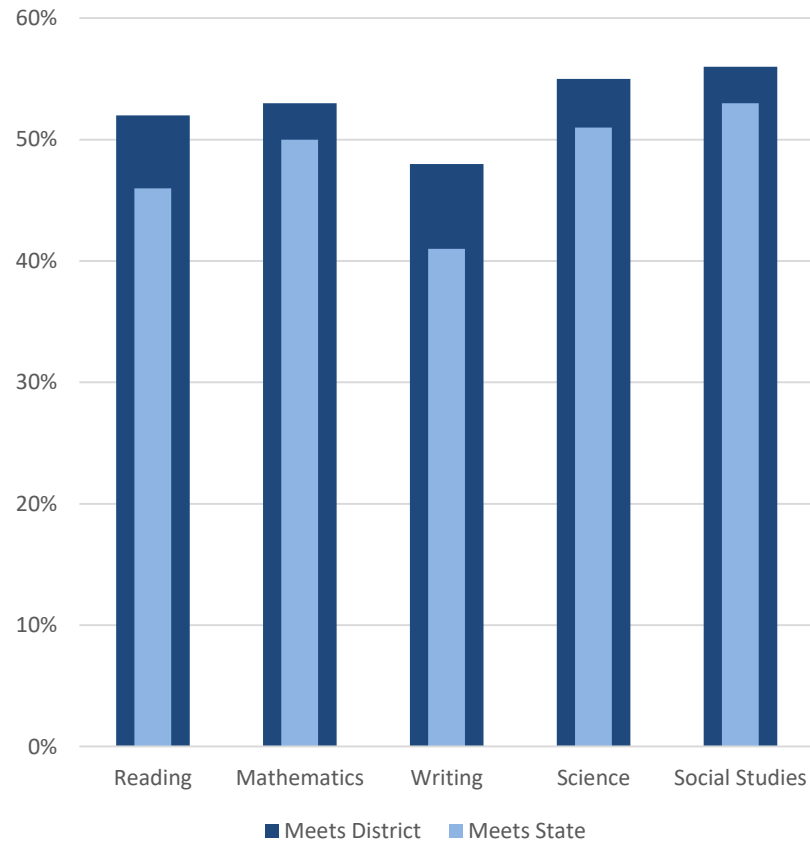


Denton ISD scored above the State average in all subject areas and performance standards

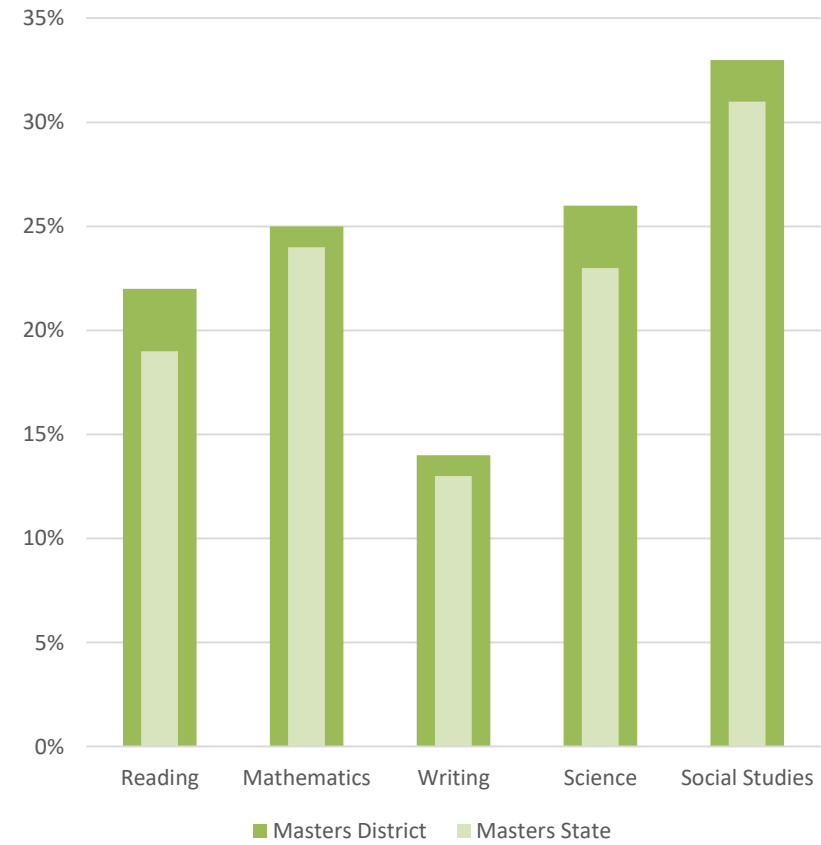
STAAR Percent at **Approaches** Grade Level or Above, All Grades



STAAR Percent at **Meets** Grade Level or Above, All Grades

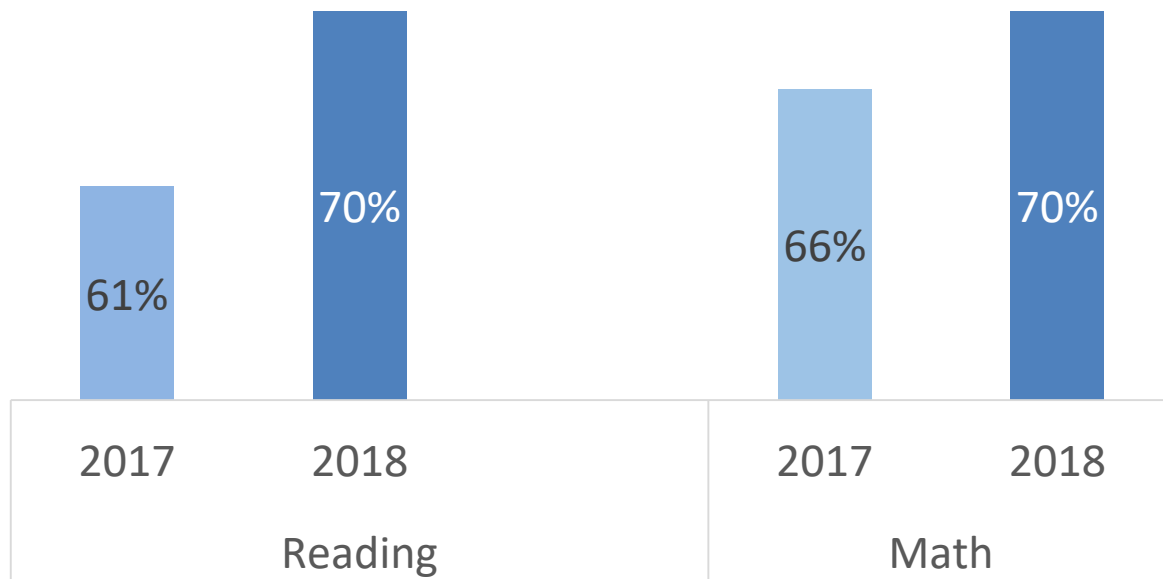


STAAR Percent at **Masters** Grade Level or Above, All Grades



70% of the students achieved **Academic Growth (Progress)** on the STAAR assessments for Reading and Mathematics, an **increase of 7%** from last year.

Met Progress



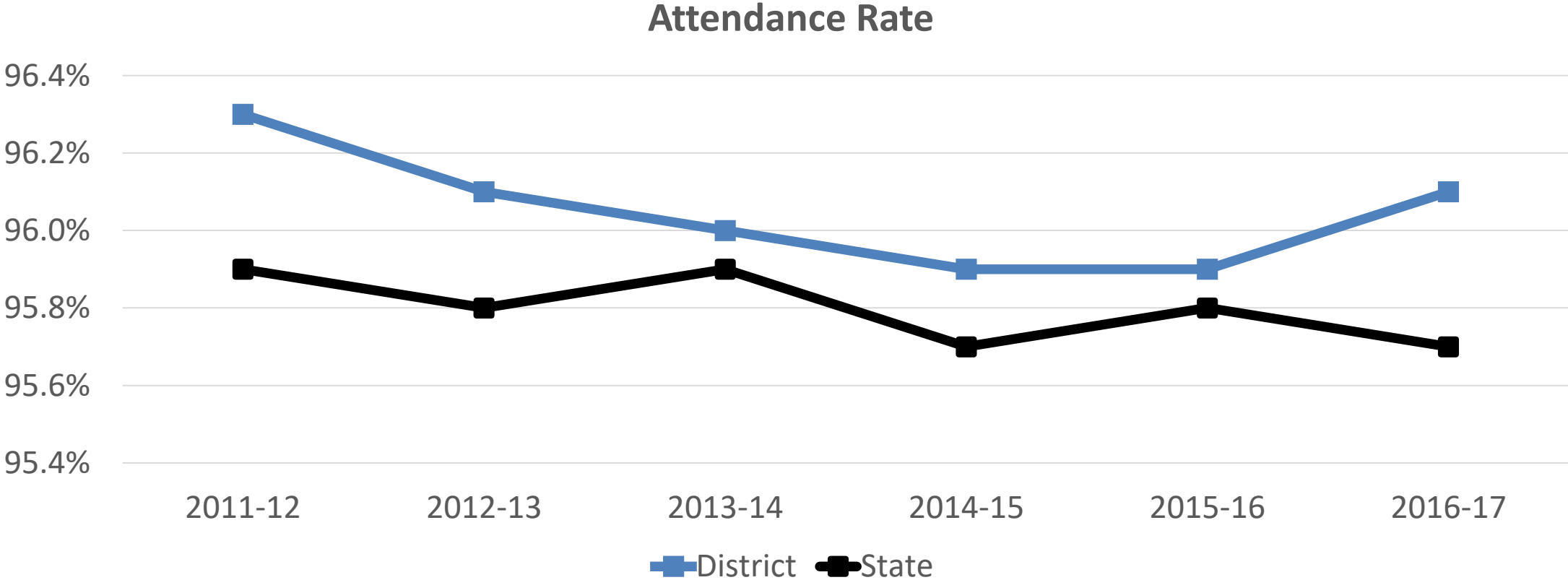
The most significant increase was among students who were not proficient on the prior year's test.

Almost **100%** of our students were tested, which is above the state norm of 99%.

The participation rate must be at least **95%**.

Not all students tested are included in accountability. Approximately **6%** were excluded due to mobility or other factors.

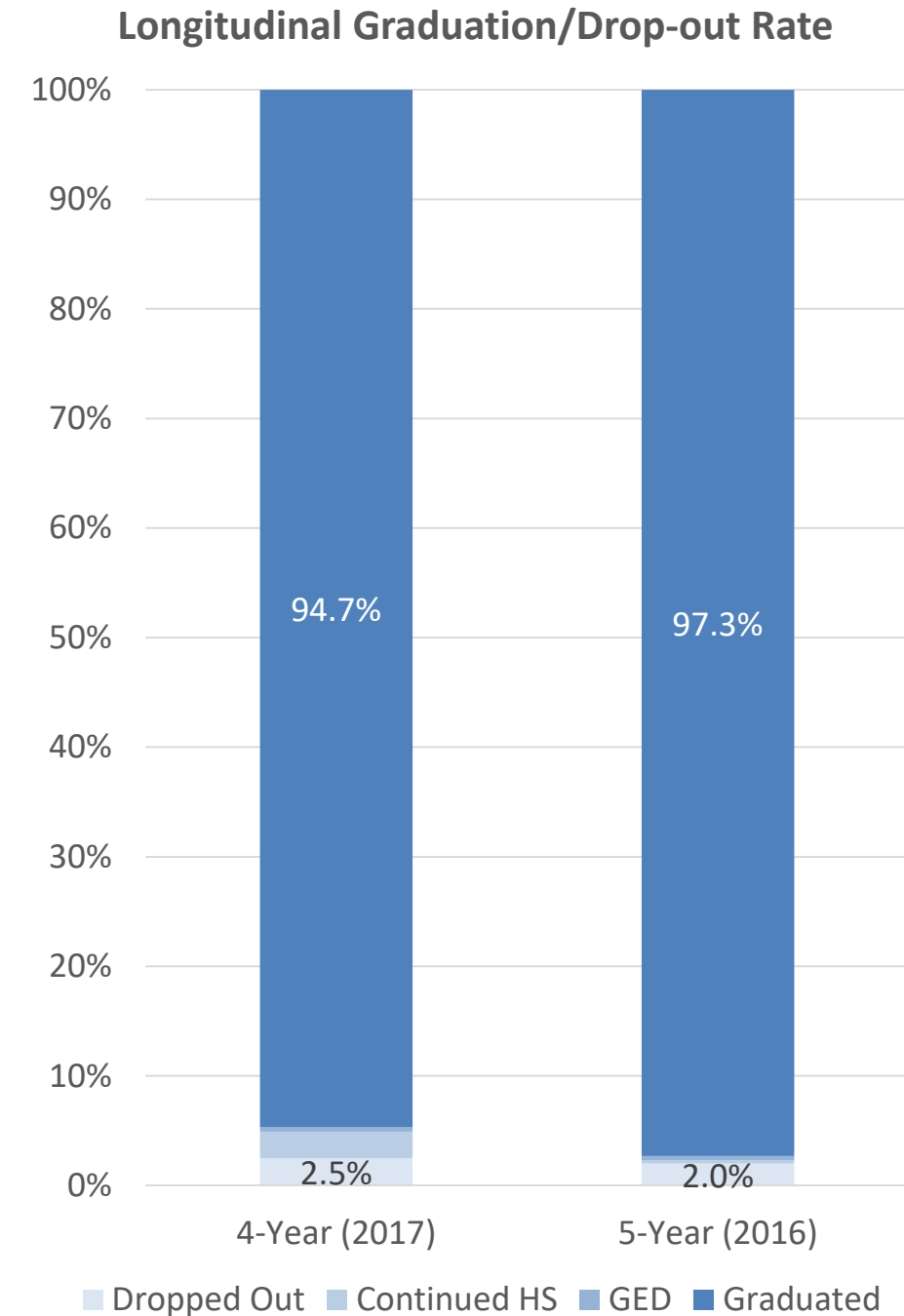
The **District** attendance rate has changed course, even though the **State** rate is in decline.



Approximately **0.5%** of students in Denton ISD drop out of school each year.

DISD longitudinal graduation is the cohort of 9th graders expected to graduate in 4 years.

Of the 2017 graduates, **90.5%** received the **Recommended High School Program** or **Distinguished Achievement Program** diploma.

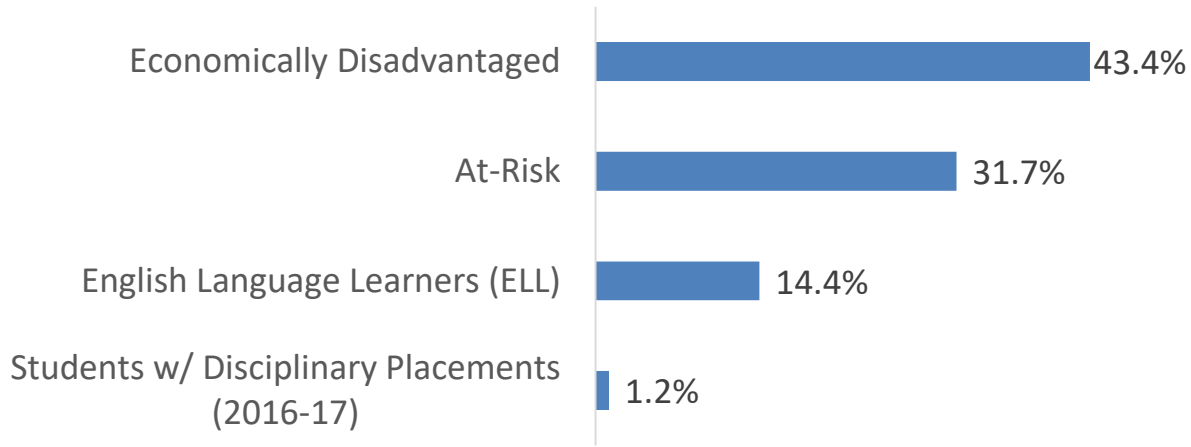


College Ready Graduates, 2016-17

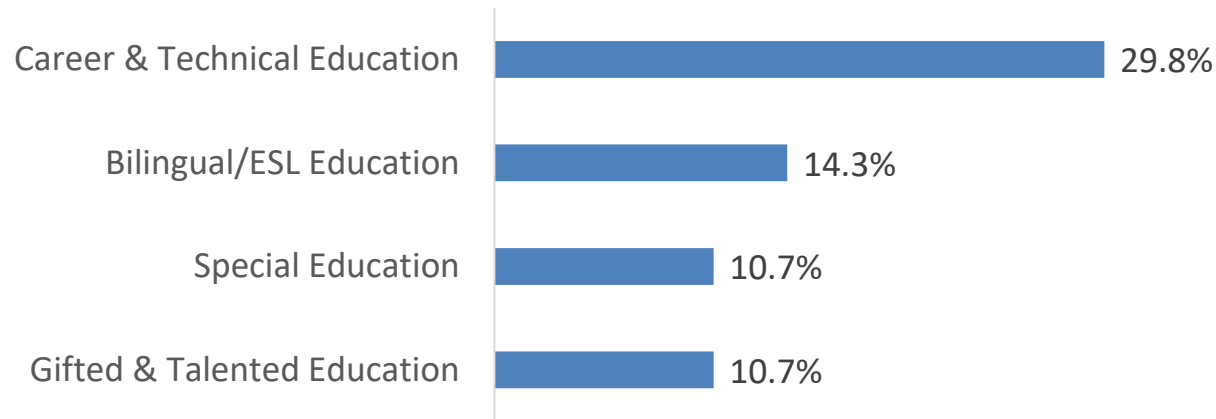

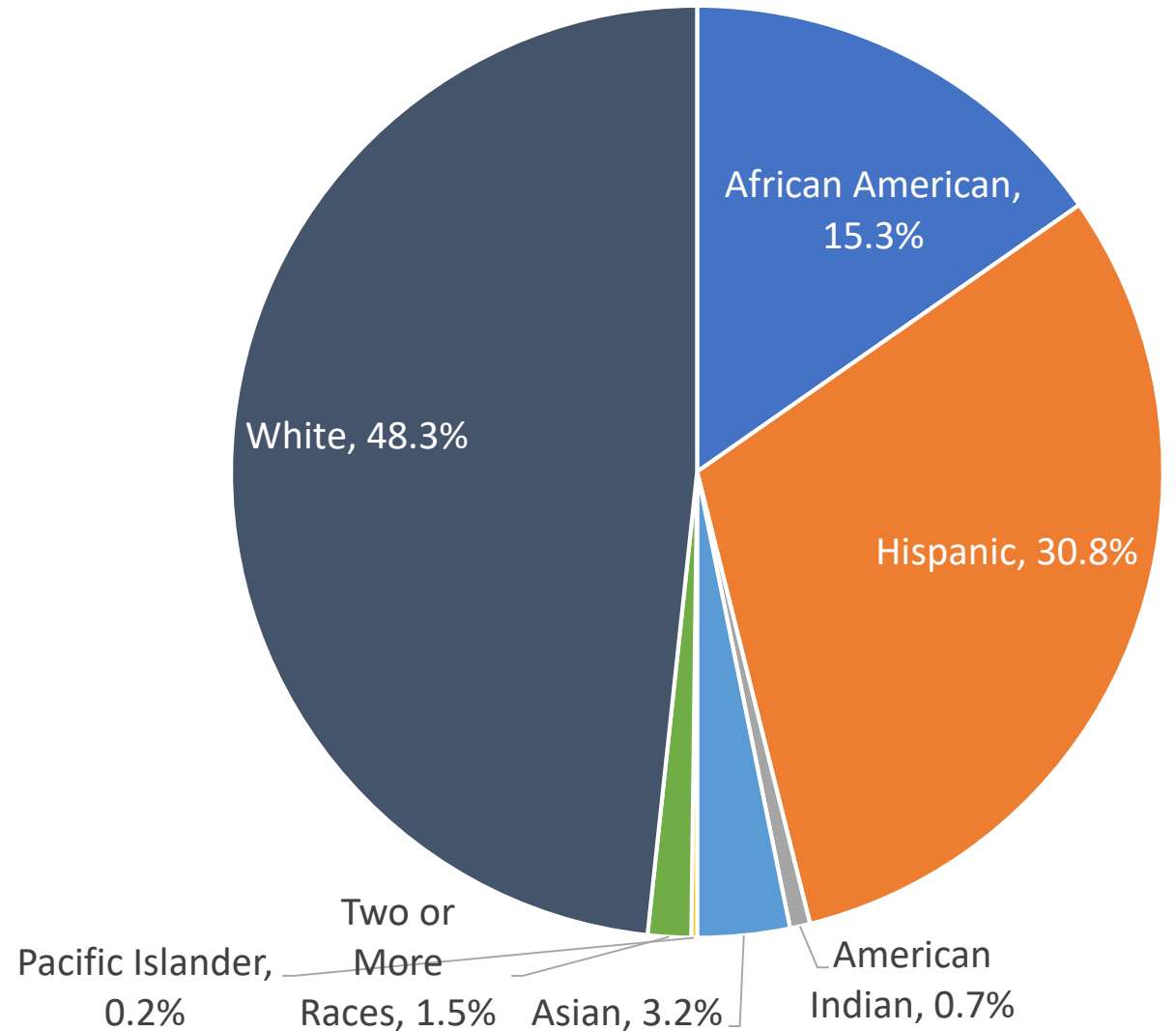
Student Demographics



Student Enrollment by Program

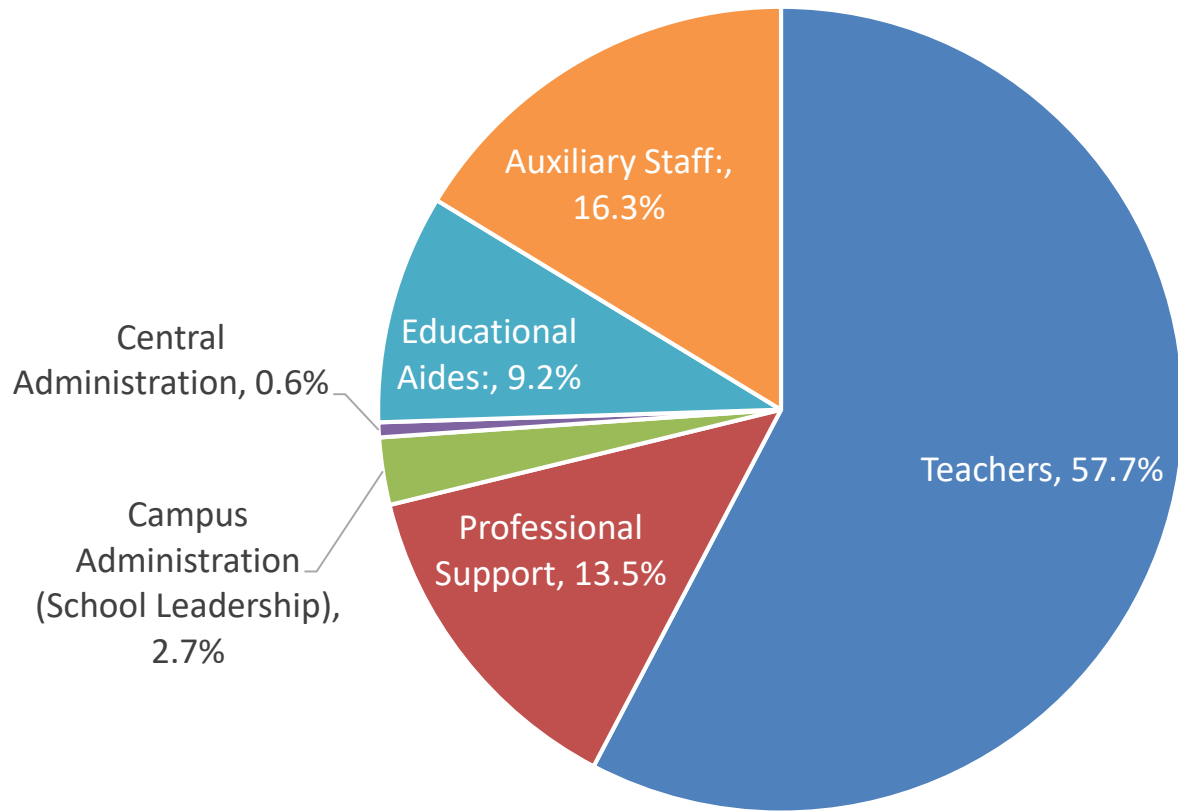


Student Ethnicity

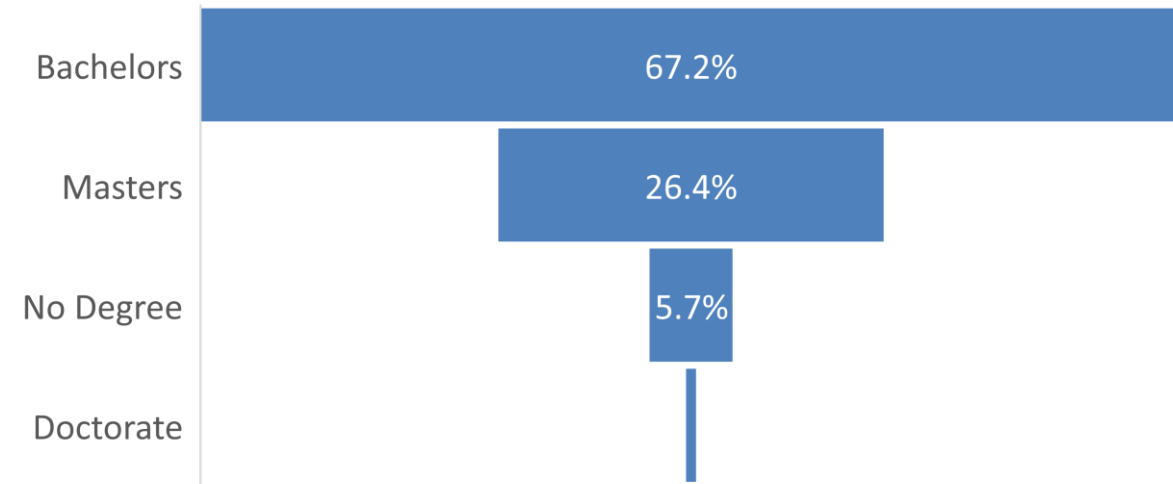
