SUMMARY:

This item requests the approval of RFP #2503-02 MDF/IDF Project.

BOARD VALUE:

Growth & Management... In pursuit of excellence, we value demonstrating effective and efficient management of district resources and providing leadership and/or oversight to ensure District meets all fiscal, legal and regulatory requirements.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

On January 10, 2023, the Board of Trustees called for the 2023 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. The bond was approved by the voters on May 6, 2023.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This proposal was issued on February 15, 2025. A total of 575 vendors were notified of the proposal. Three (3) responses were received to the proposal on March 20, 2025.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

Five (5) campus locations in the District have MDF/IDF infrastructure that has aged becoming difficult to maintain. This project will allow these campus locations to have up-to-date infrastructure for their technology needs. The cost of this project is \$1,773,628.23.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne by 2023 Bond funds.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

Passage will allow the District to upgrade the MDF/IDF components at five (5) campuses: Ryan High School, Fred Moore High School, McMath Middle School, Houston Elementary School, and McNair Elementary School.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that RFP #2503-02 MDF/IDF be awarded to Lantek Audio Video Communications, LLC.
