- Students will get 2 local Elective Credits, one for the 9th Grade Fall
   Semester and then one for the Spring Semester
- Student Schedules will include course-Campus Counselors will be trained.

- Teacher Editions and Student Workbooks- will be purchased.

- Lesson Plans will be submitted to campus administrator.
- T-TESS Evaluation will be conducted by Sped Director with input from Campus Administrator.
