




Data Considerations


- The purpose of a screener is to provide actionable data to help target instruction for each student
- The district utilizes multiple data points to assess student progress (formal and informal)
 - teacher observational data
 - formative assessments
 - district common assessments
 - benchmarks
 - screeners
- A student that does not meet a prescribed middle of year target or cut point may have still made academic progress
 - Student does not meet individual MAP growth target (7 points), but still made progress (6 points)
 - Student starts the year classified as "well below", student makes a half year of growth and is still classified as "well below" at middle of year
- If a student does not make any growth from beginning to middle of year then we need to identify contributing factors
 - Student is lacking universal skills (reading, writing, number sense, English Language, social and academic behaviors, etc.) and needs additional supports
 - Invalid assessment results (rapid guessing, misalignment with other data points)
 - Chronic absences




Developmental Reading Assessment: Kinder






Developmental Reading Assessment: 1st and 2nd








IXL Math Diagnostic: K-2




MAP BOY to MOY Comparison: District Reading




MAP BOY to MOY Comparison: Reading 3-5




MAP BOY to MOY Comparison: Reading 6-8




MAP BOY to MOY Comparison: Reading 9-10




MAP BOY to MOY Comparison: District Math




MAP BOY to MOY Comparison: Math 3-5
