Re: High School Graduation rate and Absenteeism

We would appreciate your addressing some concerns we have about our Parkrose Schools.

Recent articles in <u>The Oregonian</u> describe Oregon's high school graduation rate, after four years, to be 69%, the second worse in the nation. "Parkrose School District saw a slip in its overall graduation rate, which fell to 60 percent in 2013 from 65% in 2012." *The Oregonian, Feb. 12, 2014.*

What steps is the Parkrose School Board taking to reverse this troubling trend of low high school graduation?

Also, students can not learn or graduate if they don't attend classes. Another <u>Oregonian</u> series described Oregon's school absenteeism as "epidemic." *The Oregonian, Feb. 16, 2014.* How is Parkrose School District tracking student absences and keeping in touch with students and their families? Could it be improved?

We all want Parkrose children to learn in school and to succeed in life. Thank you for considering our concerns about our children.
