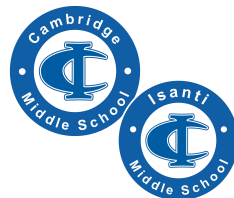
# 2024-25 Continuation and New Additions

- Time for staff to get to know students on a more personable level

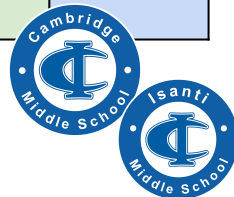

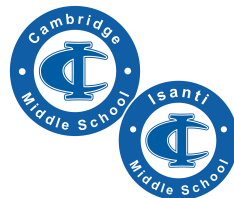
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# Student Council → Principal Advisory Role
