DESCRIPTION:

State law requires that school districts which enroll ten or more American Indian students establish an American Indian Parent Advisory Committee to afford parents the opportunity to express their views concerning educational needs of the American Indian children enrolled in the school district.

The Advisory Committee must pass a resolution indicating satisfaction with the district's current programs in meeting the needs of the American Indian students, or make recommendations to the school board to improve educational opportunities for these students.

Each American Indian student's family in our district was invited to participate in the American Indian Parent Advisory Committee meeting held on January 23, 2018 at 5:00 pm. No parents came to participate in the meeting.
