SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quote from Communication Concepts in the amount of \$164,047.47 for the fire alarm renovation purchase for Pecan Creek Elementary School.

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018, the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

This fire alarm renovation equipment and installation will be purchased through the Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative (BuyBoard). This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

The cost will be borne through the 2018 Bond Authorization.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to order and have the fire alarm renovation equipment installed as soon as feasible.
