In-District Elective Transfer

Attendance Zones

Board Policy 4.54.1

The Board recognizes the importance of establishing and maintaining school attendance zones within the District. The Board also believes that for these attendance zones to serve the best interests of the District and community, they must be reviewed regularly. Although these zones may change annually, to achieve these goals, the Board will review all school attendance zones within the District at a minimum of every three (3) years.

Assignment of Schools

Board Policy 4.54.2

The District is divided into attendance zones that have specific boundaries. Each legal resident in an attendance area may attend the local school that serves that attendance area. However, there may be times when the administration will be forced to place students out of their normal attendance area when circumstances demand.

Additionally, at times, it may be necessary for the Board to alter the attendance areas (zones) for just and reasonable causes. Students seeking to attend a school that is not in their designated attendance area must secure approval from the Executive Director of Student Services. Any students who might transfer into the District from outside the District's boundaries will be assigned to a school by the Executive Director of Student Services.

Employees of the District may choose to have their own children attend any school in the District if space is available. Any questions about space availability will be determined by the Executive Director of Student Services. Once the school election has been made, the employee's child is expected to remain at their school of choice for one school year. All transportation responsibilities will be provided by the employee. Administrative Policy for AAE's

Elementary AAE's

Traditionally issued on 4th day of school until the 20th day of the semester. AAE's will be issued the first 20 days of the second semester. All AAE's are issued based on space availability.

All elementary AAE's will be valid for one school year as long as the student maintains good discipline and attendance. The portion in italics is no longer the practice...under Dr. Gooden a revision was made that once a student uses an AAE the student is a member of that school.

Beginning in 2021 elementary school AAE's began on the Tuesday after Labor Day.

Administrative Policy for AAE's

Secondary AAE's

Secondary AAE's will be issued the first school day following Winter Break until July 1 for the following school year. Transfers may be issued after July 1, but the student will not be eligible for AAA competition for a full calendar year. AAE's will be issued for the first 20 days of each semester.

Due to high student enrollment, limits may be observed for some secondary schools.

All secondary AAE's will be valid as long as the student remains in the assigned school and *maintains good discipline and attendance*. The portion in italics is no longer the practice...under Dr. Gooden a revision was made that once a student uses an AAE the student is a member of that school.

Are informed in writing...AAE's are contingent on space availability

Are informed in writing...Transportation is the sole responsibility of the parent
