Re: Approval of CISD Dual Credit Service Agreement (MOU) with Dallas College

The Dual Credit Service Agreement establishes the partnership framework that allows eligible high school students to enroll in college-level coursework through Dallas College while simultaneously earning both high school and college credit. This partnership supports the district's commitment to expanding postsecondary readiness opportunities and increasing access to rigorous academic pathways for students.

Participation in dual credit courses provides students with significant benefits, including:

- Earning transferable college credit while in high school
- Reducing future college tuition costs and time to degree completion
- Increasing college readiness and exposure to postsecondary expectations
- Expanding opportunities for career and technical education pathways

This agreement is consistent with state dual credit requirements under Texas Education Code and aligns with the district's strategic goals related to college, career, and military readiness (CCMR).
