Our total estimated textbook affordability student savings rose to \$5,873,606.61 as of the end of this academic year. Next year is a data gathering and reporting year, so we'll see a significant jump in estimated savings once those numbers are in.

CCC Library is participating in the National Games & Libraries Project, a nationwide project exploring how games-based approaches can expand library innovation, community engagement, and digital inclusion. CCC Library began offering Games-based Library Services in Winter term based on student feedback and in-library use of board games and puzzles.
