Consider Budget and Warranty Limitation Determination Under Transportation Code §547.701

Background:

Texas Senate Bill 536 requires 3-point seat belts in all buses, unless the Board determines that there are budgetary constraints or warranty impacts that would prevent retrofit or replacement. We have provided detailed statistics as required, along with our long-range bus replacement plan. Based on the budgetary and warranty limitations of retrofitting old buses that are nearing the end of their life cycle at an estimated cost of \$5.3 million, we recommend that we continue with our planned replacement cycle using Capital Projects funds. This plan represents the most cost effective and fiscally responsible approach and will ensure full compliance by 2032.
