ELECTION of SCHOOL BOARD VICE PRESIDENT

Background:

The president of the board will call for nominations; the nominations need not be seconded. The board will then vote on the nominations.

The election of the vice president . . . may, if the Board so chooses, be by written ballot. However, in order to comply with the requirement of the Iowa Open Meetings law, each member must identify his/her ballot. Each ballot will then be attributed as it is tallied.

The president will announce the results and administer the oath of office to the vice-president.
