Background Information and Rationale:

A School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) is a group appointed by the school district to serve at the district level. Members of the SHAC come from different areas of the community and from within the school district. The majority of members must be parents who are not employed by the district. Texas law (<u>Texas Education</u> <u>Code</u>, <u>Title 2</u>, <u>Subtitle F</u>, <u>Chapter 28</u>, <u>Subchapter A</u>, <u>§28.004</u>) requires the establishment of a SHAC for every school district. SHACs are required to meet at least four times each year.

SHAC Bylaws state we should have 13-17 members with the majority of its members being parents. SHAC is bringing some character trait program recommendations that meet the health TEKS and best meet the needs of our students while aligning with community expectations today for your approval.

Support of Strategic Goals:
