Program Structure & Oversight

CURRENT (2024–2025):

- Floresville ISD acts as Educational Fiscal Agent.
- JJAEP serves expelled and court-ordered youth aged 10–17.
- Eligible offenses include Title V felonies, threats, sexual offenses.
- Juvenile Board provides general program oversight.

Program Structure & Oversight

PROPOSED (2025–2026):

- Same structure and agents.
- Now explicitly includes 18–19-year-olds (with qualifying offenses).
- Clarifies responsibilities between Educational Fiscal Agent and Juvenile Board, especially when policy conflicts arise.

Finance, Services & Responsibilities

CURRENT (2024-2025):

Annual fee of 10K plus overage costs. Any student in excess of 180 days, daily rate of \$56.00

Wilson County funds **70%**, Karnes County **30%**

Home districts keep ADA funding & handle special education costs.

Meal costs assigned to students or districts.

Finance, Services & Responsibilities (continued)

PROPOSED (2025–2026):

New Daily Rate:

\$100/day for Wilson/Karnes County students.

\$150/day for out-of-county students.

Court Ordered placements are paid for by Wilson County.

Rate adjustable yearly, with advance notice deadlines (Nov 1 / Jan 15).

Finance, Services & Responsibilities (continued)

Districts must cover:

Special education & 504 services.

Any student misconduct costs (e.g., damages, litigation).

PEIMS accountability stays with home districts

Logistics, Reporting & Legal Terms

CURRENT (2024–2025):

Districts manage truancy enforcement.

Program reports to home districts for accountability and compliance.

No indemnity between parties.

Logistics, Reporting & Legal Terms

PROPOSED (2025–2026):

Clarified PEIMS data expectations, including Code 13 for court orders.

More detailed training and staff development language.

Transportation explicitly excluded from JJAEP responsibilities.

Annual renewal or exit requires **written notice by Jan 15**.

Reiterates no waiver of governmental immunity.
