District Need

JTHS serves a diverse student population, with 58% of students identifying as Hispanic and many speaking Spanish at home. Additionally, 17% of students are classified as English Learners (ELs), and 66% are considered low-income. The district has seen a rise in the Newcomer population, prompting the need for a more comprehensive professional development of all faculty working with Multilingual populations. As part of this initiative, CTE teachers will be expected to learn more about the MLs in their classrooms and implement practical instructional activities that

support accessibility to their curricula. By providing skill-based, career-relevant language instruction in authentic, hands-on settings, MLs can develop both language proficiency and technical skills simultaneously. Research suggests that when students are actively involved in real-world tasks, authentic problem-solving, and hands-on learning, they are more likely to:

- Engage deeply with the material
- Make connections between school and life/work
- Develop skills needed for both higher education and employment (Finch et al., 1997)

Developing students' speaking and listening skills (oracy) is crucial in CTE settings, where communication is key to workplace success. Incorporating activities such as group discussions, presentations, and collaborative projects can enhance MLs' oracy skills, leading to improved confidence and participation. (Advance CTE 2022, June)
