4. Athletic Code Updated Ready for Approval
- A. In addition to the Academic Eligibility Standards, student-athletes that receive an “F” grade and/or below minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 will be deemed ineligible for the selected time frame as outlined in the Code.
 - B. Updated Consequences for breaching the 24-Hour Rule. Rule requires parents/guardians to wait a minimum of 24 hours after the completion of any scheduled game/contest, before approaching the coach with questions, and/or concerns.
