Model schools are high poverty schools that are rated within the top 5% of all Title One Schools in the state.

Mr. Christensen from our Camp Sunrise Classroom became our 3rd grade teacher and students and families welcomed him with open arms. He is doing an excellent job of adjusting to a new job assignment.

There will be several harvest related craft projects, an obstacle course, a pumpkin decorating contest, as well as tours of our garden. This is a great night to celebrate with families.
