Transportation will be provided to and from preschool to students living in the Nehalem Attendance Zone in the AM and to students living in the Garibaldi Attendance Zone in the PM.

The district is offering a sliding scale and payment plans to help families for whom the cost is a concern. **No child will be turned away for lack of ability to pay.**



LET'S TALK DRESS CODE

With the recent warm weather, it is time to review our dress code. According to our Elementary Student/Parent Handbook, page 23:

To stay in line with the expectations of the other schools in the district, the following specifics have been added to the dress code.

1. Clothing or other adornments which promote alcohol/tobacco/drugs, or have offensive/profane pictures or sayings are not permitted.
2. Clothing must cover the back and the front of the student (bare midriff, bare lower back while sitting and/or standing, halter tops, spaghetti straps, low cut, extremely short or see through clothing, and exposed undergarments are not acceptable).
3. Jewelry that could accidentally or intentionally inflict injury to oneself or others (sharp items, nails, pins, spikes, chains, or the like).

If students are found to be in conflict with dress code, the student will be given an opportunity to make the necessary corrections. If this is not possible, the office will need to intervene with a change of clothing or contact home for alternate clothing. In all cases, it is our desire to maintain the dignity of the student.

POSITIVE BEHAVIOR INTERVENTIONS and SUPPORTS

As we enter into our last few months of school we are still practicing our 3 school rules:

Staff are trying to reinforce the kids when they make good choices by handing out individual way to go slips. We also hand out feathers when a whole class is making good choices.

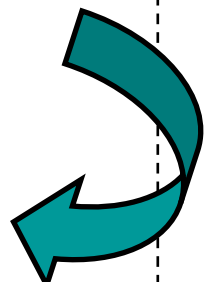

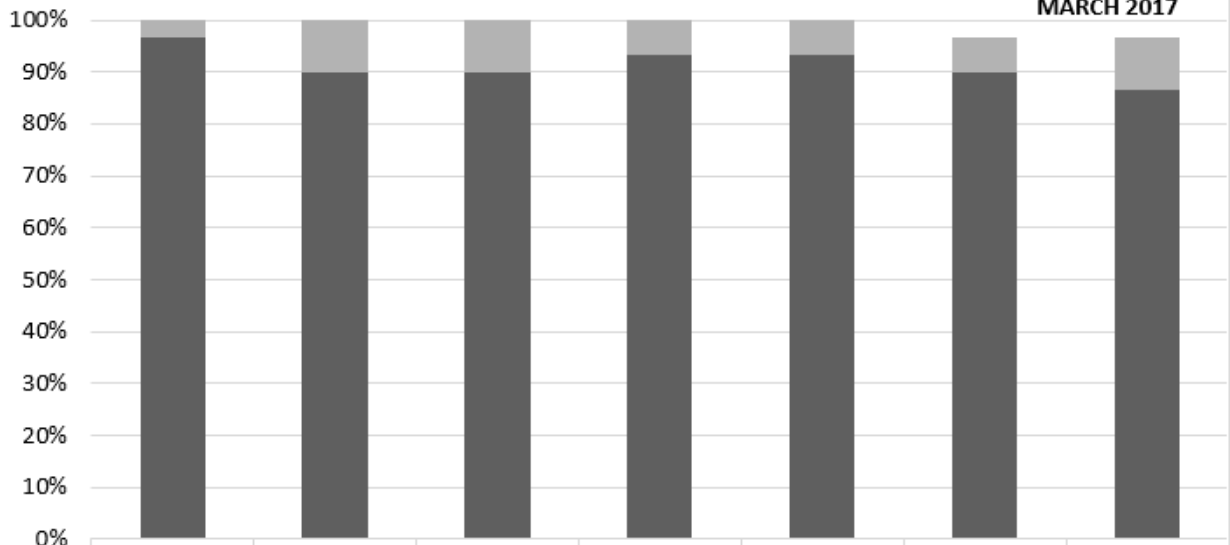

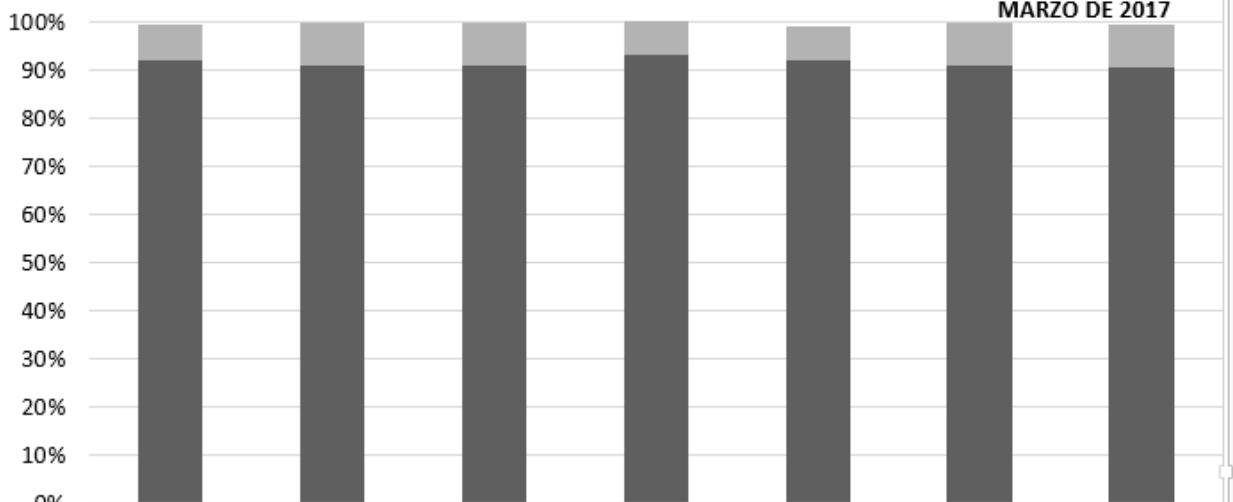
