Basics of CTE



- a. 14 Career Clusters
 - i. 60 programs of study
- b. Level 1 Level 4 Courses
- c. Texas incentivizes students that complete pathways (Level 4) by labeling students concentrators and completers and by incorporating with CCMR and elevating funding

STEM as a Career Pathway was dissolved

 Engineering, Computer Science, and Biomedical Science (programs of study) moved

Engineering is its own career pathway with 6 new programs of study

 We offer Engineering Foundations, Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering, and Electrical Engineering

Computer Science moved into Information Technology Pathway Biomedical Science moved into Health Science Pathway

New to Midway

- 1. Exercise Science, Wellness, and Restoration (NEW)
- 2. Diagnostic & Therapeutic Services (combined Healthcare Diagnostics, Healthcare Therapeutics, Medical Therapy, and Nursing Science)
- 3. Engineering Foundations, Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering, and Electrical Engineering (All Separate Programs of Study)
- 4. Real Estate (NEW)
- 5. Robotics and Automation Technology (New Courses coming)

Changing Industry Based Certifications



TEA is proposing changes to how certifications count and are earned for CCMR

Each certification will be tiered as determined by labor market data and set by the Texas Education Agency

- 1. Aligned to in-demand AND high wage occupations
- 2. Aligned to in-demand OR high wage occupations
- 3. Does not meet either indicator

Certifications will then be given a numeric calculation that will deem students as percentages of College and Career Ready

 To Earn full CCMR point, student must be a completer (3 or more courses for 4 or more credits and earn Tier 1 IBC
