Student Council is working on planning events for Pirate Palooza and Prom that can be implemented regardless of county metrics.

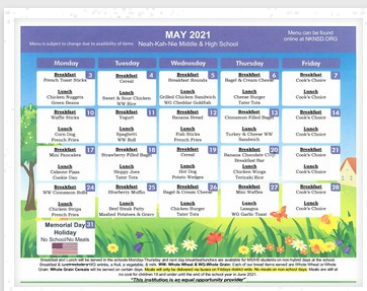


Elections for next year's student council are coming up; the outgoing Seniors will start putting together election packets and information for anyone interested in running.
