On August 3rd, eight NMS teachers participated in co-teacher training from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at NMS. The training focused on effective co-teaching strategies, building strong collaborative relationships, planning and delivering instruction together, differentiating instruction, increasing student engagement, supporting diverse learning needs, and using data to monitor student progress. The training provided teachers with practical strategies to create more inclusive and effective learning environments for all students.
