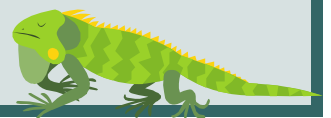




Dear Parent,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that there have been some changes concerning re-testing students in grades 3 through 8 who have met or exceeded the Oregon Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (OAKS) for the 2011-2012 school year.

While students in grades 3-8 are required to take the OAKS assessment, as of January 2012, the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) is requiring Oregon districts to notify parents of an “opt out” choice for retesting their child. Schools may test a student a second or third time on the OAKS assessment if they met or exceeded the achievement standards at their grade level during the first testing opportunity.

If you do not want your child to be retested after they have met or exceeded the OAKS assessment, please send in writing your request to the school principal.
