BP 5131.5 Vandalism, Theft and Graffiti

The School Board considers vandalism a very serious matter. Vandalism includes the negligent, willful, or unlawful damaging or theft of any district-owned real or personal property, including the writing of graffiti.

Any district student who commits an act of vandalism shall be subject to disciplinary action, must make reparation for damages, and also may be reported to the appropriate authorities for legal prosecution. If reparation of damages is not made, the district also may withhold the student's report card, diploma and/or transcriptslaw enforcement.
