## PLEASE KEEP STUDENTS WITH SYMPTOMS OUT OF SCHOOL

This list is school instructions, not medical advice. Please contact your health care provider with health concerns.

### SYMPTOMS OF ILLNESS

**Fever:** temperature of 100.4°F (38°C) or greater



New **cough** illness



New **difficulty breathing**



**Diarrhea:** 3 loose or watery stools in a day **OR** not able to control bowel movements



**Vomiting:** one or more episode that is unexplained



**Headache with stiff neck and fever**

**Skin rash or open sores**

**Red eyes with colored drainage**

**Jaundice:** new yellow color in eyes or skin

**Acting differently without a reason:** unusually sleepy, grumpy, or confused.

**Major health event,** like an illness lasting 2 or more weeks **OR** a hospital stay, **OR** health condition requires more care than school staff can safely provide.

### THE STUDENT MAY RETURN AFTER...

\*The list below tells the shortest time to stay home.  
A student may need to stay home longer for some illnesses.

\***Fever-free for 24 hours** without taking fever-reducing medicine.

\* **Symptoms improving for 24 hours** (no cough or cough is well-controlled).

\* **Symptoms improving for 24 hours** (breathing comfortably). ***Urgent medical care may be needed.***

\***Symptom-free for 48 hours OR** with orders from doctor to school nurse.

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\***Symptom-free OR** with orders from doctor to school nurse. Follow fever instructions above. ***Urgent medical care may be needed.***

\***Symptom free**, which means rash is gone OR sores are dry or can be completely covered by a bandage **OR** with orders from doctor to school nurse.

\***Symptom-free**, which means redness and drainage are gone **OR** with orders from doctor to school nurse.

\***After the school has orders** from doctor or local public health authority to school nurse.

\***Symptom-free**, which means return to normal behavior **OR** with orders from doctor to school nurse.

\***After the school has orders** from doctor to school nurse **AND** after measures are in place for the student's safety. Please work with school staff to address special health-care needs so the student may attend safely.







# Parent Guide to Student Medications at School

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The school medication law is designed to protect student and school staff from harm. In order to administer medication to students the following requirements must be met:

1. **Medication must be brought into the school office by the parent/guardian.**
  - Please do not send medication on the bus or in with your child.
2. **Medication must be in the original container.**
  - If medication needs to be split or cut please do so prior to bringing to school.
  - If medication needs to be crushed, please send pill crusher.
  - If medication needs to be measured please send a correctly calibrated measurement device (i.e. liquid medication spoon).
3. **School medication form must be filled out and signed.**
  - Forms are available in school office.
  - If medication changes, a new form must be filled out and a new bottle with an accurate label must be brought to school.

 <p>Prescription medication in original container with a pharmacy label. If your child has an inhaler make sure a label is on the inhaler or on the box sent with the inhaler.</p>	 <p>Prescription medication in a medication bottle without a pharmacy label. Medication in the wrong bottle or a different dose than it says on the label.</p>
 <p>Over the counter medication in the original packaging <u>with your child's name written on the container</u> - this includes cough drops and eye drops. Over the counter medication must be FDA approved.</p>	 <p>Over-the-counter medication in a baggie, envelope or any container that is not the original container. Doses that are not recommended by the manufacturer.</p>

We will not dispense medication to student unless above instructions are followed.
