The 21st Century Summer Program will offer services for the following months June and July. Our Summer Program is located at Napi Elementary School. We have been collaborating with Summer School and BWAP Summer Programs. Our Program is based on STREAM Experiments/Activities (Science, Technology, Reading, Arts & Math) Family engagement activities will be offered weekly.

Here is some of the activities that will be offered.

*Lava *Volcano making *Playdough *Paper Rockets *Skittles Experiment *Kite Experiments *Boat Experiment

- Cultural Cooking - Basic cooking/baking recipes (age/grade appropriate)
- Art's and Craft's projects ranging from drawing, coloring, building towers and painting projects.
- Poetry/art exhibit
- Gardening – Gardening project's
- Exercising – daily exercising
- Google Earth – Virtual Tours of historic places from around the world.
- Drones – Intro to learning to fly drones.
- Robotics – Building solar robots.
- Blackfeet Star Story – Star Story lessons with telescopes. (Star Gazing).
- Weekly Field Trips

The 21st Century Summer Program recently visited the Giant Springs State Park in Great Falls, Mt. Students learned about all the different reptiles (snakes) in our region. They also visited the Fish Hatchery at the Park.

On Wednesday June 16th our students participated in the liNNII Days at Smith Ranch, they learned the importance of the buffalo. A buffalo hide was presented to all the people and students were called to help with tacking it to the ground and scraping/tanning the hide. (I attached some pictures of the students.)
