- The Site Team has met to come up with some additional interventions for students who are failing classes and at risk of needing credit recovery.
- We are going to re-organize how we utilize our Guided Study and Math intervention time to offer more targeted support for students who are struggling with math homework.
- We are also going to utilize our Advisory period for more targeted interventions with students who are currently failing core classes.
