All students are participating in our first NWEA screening of this year. Each student will complete a math and a reading screening. These provide their teachers with vital information regarding each individual student's strengths and weaknesses.

Throughout our campus we are focusing on our campus theme "HES Chooses Love! We are #OneFamily" which goes hand-in-hand with our Restorative Discipline approach.

KINDERGARTEN

We are working in our Reading Street curriculum, paying special attention to the comprehension skill of identifying the setting of a story. We also learned the difference between fiction and non-fiction stories. In Math, we continued recognizing and writing numbers 0-5. We even took our first Math test for a grade this week!

FIRST GRADE

This week in first grade has been magnificent. In ELAR we started learning about the 5 Ws in a story. The kids love retelling fairy tales. In math we began learning how to add up to 10. In social studies we continued talking about being a good citizen and talking about the symbols of our country.

SECOND GRADE

2nd graders are learning how to use context clues and the 5 W's and H question strategies (who, what, when, where, why, and how) that good readers use to understand their books. We've also continued to brainstorm and write small personal narratives to share in class. During math students are working with number lines to order numbers and look at patterns. They've also enjoyed learning about important and influential people from our history who exhibited individualism and inventiveness. Students have been very inventive as they used different materials to build bridges during their Eagle Soar time.
